

Claire Henchcliffe, M.D., D.Phil. is the Chair and Stanley van den Noort Professor of Neurology, University of California, Irvine since 2020. Prior to this, she spent 17 years at Weill Cornell Medical College (WCMC)/New York Presbyterian Hospital, New York City, becoming Professor of Neurology and Neuroscience, and Vice Chair for Clinical Research in Neurology. Her undergraduate and graduate training was completed at the University of Oxford, University of Cambridge, UK, and the University of California at Berkeley, followed by neurology residency training and movement disorder fellowship at the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Columbia University in New York City. Her clinical and research focus is on Parkinson's disease and related neurodegenerative disorders, including working to develop new Parkinson's disease therapeutics such as stem cell-based interventions.
