Claire Henchcliffe, M.D., D.Phil. has served as Chair and Stanley van den Noort Professor of Neurology, University of California, Irvine since 2020. Her undergraduate and graduate training were completed at the University of Oxford (MA, DPhil) UK, and she completed her medical training including movement disorders fellowship at the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Columbia University in New York City. Following 17 years at Weill Cornell Medical College (WCMC) New York, she moved to UC Irvine where she serves as Chair. She has focused on expansion of the department's missions, including staffing a new hospital and new research center. At a departmental level she has strengthened the research faculty pipeline, including support for NIH career development candidates and awardees. Her own clinical and research focus is on Parkinson's disease, including working to develop new Parkinson's disease therapeutics such as stem cell-based interventions. She currently serves on the Board of the ANA and as President Elect of the AUPN. She is deeply committed to mentoring the next generations of neurologists/clinical neuroscientists and serves at a local and national level to foster career development and growth of a diverse workforce.
